**Curriculum-Based Measures** 

- Take about 1 minute
- Multiple formats
- Standardized items
- Sensitive to growth
- Focused on specific skills

#### **Computer-Adaptive Tests**

• Can take more than 15 minutes

• Online only

- Items vary for each student
- Lacks sensitivity to growth
- Focused on many skills
